

Official Rules

13th Annual 2018 United Way Ice Fishing Jamboree

- Registration at Stack's Bay starting at 7:00am Saturday February 3rd 2018.
- Registration Fee is \$25 for Adults - \$5 for Kids. Tickets are non refundable.
- If by chance we have unsafe ice, we are still having a get together with food and door prizes. All door prizes will still be given away.
- You will receive a numbered wristband during registration. You must have your wristband on in order to eat. The same wristband will be used for door prize drawings.
- Must register by 11:00 am to be eligible for largest fish prizes
- All Fish entered for cash prize awards must be brought to the registration table at Stacks Bay IMMEDIATELY, as this Jamboree committee supports CATCH AND RELEASE. Fish will be measured by the judges to the nearest ¼", following official DNR fish measuring guidelines. Judges measurements are final. No fish will be measured after 3:00pm.
- Food will be served from 11:00 am – 3:00 pm.
- Must be present to win door prizes.
- Largest fish prizes based on length of an individual fish.
- Payouts for fish prizes are
 - Northern: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$25
 - ~~Walleye~~: (Minocqua has a 5 year ban on Walleye)
 - Bluegill: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$25
 - Crappie: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$25
 - Perch: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$25
 - Bass: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$25
- The United Way Ice Fishing Jamboree Judges reserves the right to reject any fish that we feel has not been caught during the jamboree hours.
- All fish must be caught between the hours of 8:00 am – 3:00 pm on Saturday, February 3rd 2018.
- If multiple marked fish are caught, winners will split \$1500 cash prize equally.
- You must abide by all Wisconsin DNR Fishing regulations.
